It said it wanted to "create something truly awe-inspiring".

It took three years to build the ship. It weighs 237,000 tons, and is as long as the Empire State Building is high. It is 306 metres* longer than the Titanic, but the Titanic was 1.8kph faster. The ship has eight different "neighbourhoods" that will give guests different experiences. It also has 20 restaurants, four swimming pools, a water park, a basketball court, an ice-skating rink, a surf simulator, a 1400-seat theatre, and 13-metre rock-climbing walls.
