She said if the country's economy collapsed, no one could give aid to the country. The G20 leaders will talk to the Taliban about humanitarian aid. Italy's prime minister is the current leader of the G20. It said the aid would help to stop insecurity in the country. It said it would also help the Taliban to "engage positively with the world".
