Balochistan is one of Pakistan's poorest areas. It has huge natural resources. People want many issues addressed. These include human rights, autonomy, money from natural resources, and full independence. Between 2003 and 2012, an estimated 8,000 people from Balochistan were reportedly kidnapped by Pakistan. Pakistani expert Malik Siraj Akbar said: "The international community must play its role in bringing the people behind these crimes to justice."
