An expert on stamps at the British Library said the sale was like buying the 'Mona Lisa'. An anonymous buyer bought the stamp. An heir to the du Pont chemical fortune was the last owner. $\mathrm{He}^{*}$ is in prison for killing an Olympic wrestler. A 12-year-old stamp collector first found the stamp in 1873. He sold it a few years later for about $\$ 50$ in today's money. It has since had a dozen owners. Sotheby's said: "This is the most valuable item in the world by weight. It's just a tiny piece of paper." They were happy a collector bought it.
